Vendor Booth Rental and Pricing Structure

Vendors commit to the full 21 weeks of the seasonal market. Payment may be paid in full before the season begins or ½ before the season begins and ½ by July 15th. Failure to pay in full by the deadline may result in loss of booth space. Part time vendors may be considered on a case-by-case basis and subject to space availability. Booth spaces are 12'x12'; larger spaces may be available upon request for an additional charge. Acceptance is based on criteria including, but not limited to: The needs of the market (product mix), quality, compatibility with the market's demographics, past vendor track record, and booth space availability.

A full season vendor booth (21 Thursdays) is \$10.00 per week (total of \$210 for the season).

A part time vendor booth is \$20.00 per week.

For Craft Artisans:

- Business License (from local county clerk)
- Sales Tax & Use Certificate (from state department of revenue)

For Food Trucks:

- Certificate of Liability Insurance (\$1 million minimum with ALL the following listed as Additional Insureds: Rural Plains Association of Owners, Rural Plains Partnership, RPPBX Investments LLC, Boyle Nashville LLC, and Boyle Investment Company.)
- Business License (from local county clerk)
- Sales Tax & Use Certificate (from state department of revenue)
- Commissary Kitchen Agreement
- Health Department Permit/Inspection

*Local arts and crafts are permitted for sale. Crafts must be made by the vendor. Acceptance is based on criteria including, but not limited to: The needs of the market (product mix), quality, compatibility with the market's demographics, past vendor track record, and booth space availability.

*Other types of vendors will be considered on a case by case basis by market management.
